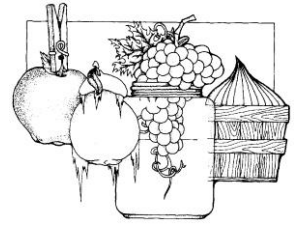


Preserving the Harvest

Workshops for Home Food Preservers



Preserving freshly harvested foods provides an opportunity to enjoy those foods throughout the year.

Freezing & Drying Workshops (for fruits and vegetables)

Water Bath Canning Workshops (for fruits, tomatoes, pickles and sweet spreads)

Pressure Canning Workshops: (for vegetables, tomatoes, meats)
